



Let me introduce you to my latest work – a “Fish” or a “Wave” – made from walnut. It is ca 5 meters long and need to be dried for a while before it is completed. It combines walnut, iron, burned natural structures and polished natural wood whit finishing oil.





My ambition now is to make up to 10 objects of this size - and bigger (up to ten meters) for an exhibition summer 2010 at Klevfos Industry Museum in Ådalsbruk.



As in many of my earlier objects I am trying to find a point of balance between making objects that has pure esthetic walue and making the objekt inspire to som possible usefulness. In this case I have made this aproach double. The object – the 5 meter long walnut – the “Fish” can be exhibited standing on there “feets” and turned around lying on the “back”.





It is an object with poetic qualities – as it is associative in many directions. As mentioned my working title is a “Wave”. And it is also a “Fish”. It has some association to icons from the world of cartoon-movies and can also be seen as a phallos. Several parts of the object reveal “flaming structure” in the wood.
